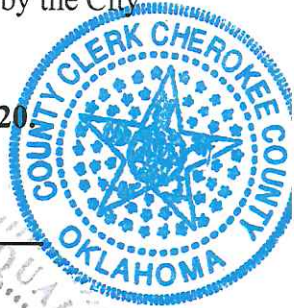

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAHLEQUAH, OKLAHOMA, THAT SECTION 13-604 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TAHLEQUAH, OKLAHOMA, IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:**

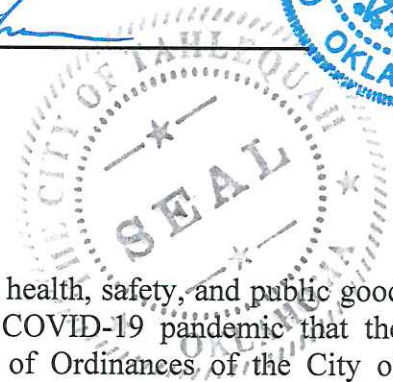
**13-604: SUNSET:** This ordinance shall expire the earlier of: March 31, 2021; the expiration of all COVID-19 related emergency declarations issued by the Governor of the State of Oklahoma and the President of the United States of America; or repeal, modification or extension by the City Council through a subsequent ordinance.


